In reviewing this finding it was determined that the SFY 2011 count of 841 served was not unduplicated. It contained duplicated admissions. The report for SFY 2011 was rerun and yielded a count of 639 unduplicated served in that year. Thus the variance from SFY 2011 to SFY 2012 is a 3% increase.

The Average LOS of children discharged from the State Hospital increased by 33%. The Average LOS of children (in facility less than a year) who were State Hospital residents at the end of the year decreased by 44%. The average LOS of adults discharged from the State Hospital increased by 20%. The following accounts for these changes from SFY 2011 to SFY 2012: The total number of admissions to residential treatment centers decreased because one unit serving adults closed decreasing the number of sites from four to three and the number of beds from 60 to 44, and there has been a concentrated effort through the children's system of care initiative to divert children from residential to community care. The average LOS of children discharged from the State Hospital increased because the SFY 2011 report contained a number of short stay discharges from a unit serving adolescents with co-occurring MR/MI which was phased out. The decrease in the average LOS of children (in facility less than one year) who were State Hospital residents at the end of the year is a "small numbers" phenomenon, with only 17 residents falling into this category. The average LOS of adults discharged from the State Hospital in SFY 2012 increased because of a continuing effort to place very long stay forensic patients in community settings.
16	It is noted that for SFY 2012 as compared to SFY 2011, there was an 18% increase in the number of consumers receiving therapeutic foster care. This is accounted for by two provider's significantly expanding capacity in this service category.
