In SFY 2013, the Data Contractor (MTM) completed a set of routines that construct virtual admissions/discharges based on contiguous dates of service. MTM reviewed the full set of code again on 12/10/2013 and believes it is producing correct numbers based on the raw data we have. 12 & 14	All calculation routines were reviewed and are logically sound. As provided in comment for table 4, the transaction system implementation issues in SFY 2013 contributed to the roughly 20% decline. The SMI/SED attributes were more fully populated as the year progressed.
15	Providers are not required to update residential status at defined intervals, only when it changes. These changes are collected on an ongoing basis as an attribute of transactions which are the substrate upon which URS reporting is based.
16 & 17	Data on EBPs is based on aggregate data reports from providers. Client level data on EBPs is not reported, the number served is not unduplicated and breakouts of demographic variables are not reported. For SMI/SED client level data is reported, the count is unduplicated and the demographic break outs are reported in tables 14A and 14B.
