3	Since 2010, Alabama has had a downward trend in patients served in state psychiatric hospitals, with 2019 being the lowest year in URS reporting. As outlined in the SAMHSA MH Block Grants over these years, ADMH closed 3 longstanding state hospitals, 2 (Searcy and Greil) at the end of 2012 and 1 (NARH) in April 2015. To close these hospitals, efforts were in place to downsize each of the hospitals that allowed the closures to occur. In December 2016, we implemented a statewide care coordination staffing process between the state hospitals and the community providers to assist with transitional care from state hospitals to community discharge.
6	The decrease in total admission to other psychiatric inpatient during the year is due to several natural patterns of psychiatric care that includes the following: longer lengths of stays by individuals in the beds; change in inpatient hospital partners which meant periods of time when beds were not accessible; and workforce issues such as when vacancies occur, certain rules and regulations require bed diversion.
7	The 21% increase in total MHBG expenditures is due to carryover of block grant funds. The 186% increase in total other funds expenditures is due to recognizing Medicare revenues in the state hospitals. This accounted for all but less than 10% which would be due to smaller federal grants. The 22% increase in other 24-hour care expenditures is due to a forensic lawsuit which added \$7 million to residential care.
7A	The \$70,000 increase is due to the mandatory FEP program. We are trying to reach the goal of approximately \$1 million.
12	Even though the percentages seem high, the numbers served are closer than the percentage implies. Also, FY17 data is more similar to FY19. The treatment of Co-Occurring individuals had no changes with programs and services. This decrease must be linked to natural patterns of service access.
14A	SMI Definition: Person who meets the diagnosis and disability criteria or who meet the criteria for high risk. Disability Criteria (must meet at least 2 criteria plus diagnosis criteria). (1) Is unemployed, is employed in a sheltered setting or has markedly limited skills and a poor work history. (2) Shows severe inability to establish or maintain personal social support systems. (3) Shows deficits in basic living skills. (4) Exhibits inappropriate social behavior. High Risk (must meet one of the criteria). (1) History of DMH/MR supported inpatient or public residential treatment as a result of an Axis I Mental Illness diagnosis. (2) Person would become at imminent risk of needing inpatient hospitalization without outpatient intervention.
