4 & 4A	There was a decrease in number of clients in Community Health Program in 2019 from 2018.
5A	Prior to February 2017 providers were not required to complete CRFs for Medicaid clients. Due to this policy change in February 2017, DSAMH began collecting information on all clients regardless of payer source. This led to an increase in clients and episodes of treatment in all program types. Since 2017 data collection for Medicaid clients has increased in accuracy. The Total number of Medicaid funded clients increased from 2018 to 2019. The Total number of Non-Medicaid funded clients decreased from 2018 to 2019.
6	The total number of mental health clients served in 2019 decreased from 2018. The State Hospital has experienced a multiyear reduction in admissions due in large part to an increase in alternative options that have led to more individuals being diverted to more appropriate services. This has led to both a decrease in the number of admissions each year as well as eliminating short LOS for clients inappropriately placed in the facility. This has led to higher mean LOS for clients admitted to the facility in 2018. Since 2017, DPC has been transitioning to an acute facility serving clients short term (30 days or less). As of 2019 the average LOS for clients in DPC has normalized to reflect the policy change to transition DPC as an acute facility serving clients short term. Short term treatment entails treatment for 30 days or less.

12	Delaware has improved it's data collection and analysis process as it relates to diagnoses and other fields which has resulted in more accurate identification of client level data and more diagnosis fields being completed accurately.
14A	The total number of mental health clients served in 2019 decreased from 2018. There were about two and half times the number of Race Not Available reported by providers in 2019 compared to 2018 from 417 in 2018 to 1,044 in 2019. The increase in unknown races reported has caused a decrease in reporting of the actual race.
15	On top of the decreased number of mental health clients served in 2019, there was a 163% increase in the number of "Unknown" selected as a residency status for the age range 18 to 64 by providers. By the increase in providers listing clients as Unknown for their residency, this has decreased the number of clients that would have otherwise been reported in various other living situation profiles.
16	The main driver of the increase in Supported Housing, ACT services results from better data collection techniques and reporting. The increase in number of children with SED stems from the overall increase in children patients. Children discharges saw an increase of about 72% from 2018 to 2019.
17	2019 experienced better data collection techniques in reporting Integrated Dual Diagnosis services and Illness Self Management services than in 2018.
21	The main driver of the change relies with children's data. Table 21 data is showing a decrease due to the unavailability of slots for residential treatment centers during FY 2019. When comparing the numbers - splitting it into children and adults the following was determined: adult totals for 2019 increased by 7% over 2018 numbers; in 2018 adults had 811 discharges and had 864 discharges in 2019; children totals for 2019 increased by 112% over 2018 numbers; in 2018, children has 1,352 discharges and had 2,864 discharges in 2019. The increase in the number for children had a substantive impact to the overall readmission rates. Although the readmission rate increased by 38% from 2018 to 2019 this was not in proportion to the total increase in the number of discharges in 2019. The total number of discharges increased about 72%, where the main driver of said discharges relates to the increase in children patients. Because the denominator (total discharges) increased disproportionately to the numerator (total readmissions at 30 and 180 days), there was a significant decrease in the readmission rates from 2018 to 2019.
