Coverage in and enrollment in the ACA continues to affect those served by our providers. The Medicaid Authority in the State of Illinois continue to make adjustments in how MCO claims are processed. Last, but not least, FY19 continued to have a lack of coverage for Non-Medicaid services. The same explanation for increased coverage of MCOs in the state would also influence admissions to the State-Operated Hospitals.
