This correction in categorization of expenditures is the primary explanation in the increase in non-24-hour care and the decrease in 24-hour care. Administration Expenditures: in Report Year 2019, the State reviewed its reporting methodology to ensure it was appropriate. It appears that in 2018, the State inappropriately reported some service costs as Administrative Expenditures. Services reported in the administrative category was the reason for the significant decrease that appeared in 2019.</p>
