4	Total Number of Consumers Employed: The twenty two percent increase in Louisiana between FY 2018 and FY 2019 is due to improvement in data quality. Louisiana Office of Behavioral Health is regularly monitoring and providing feedback to its ten health regions on quality of their client-level data.
5	Total number of consumers with both Medicaid and Non-Medicaid Funding: Like other years, Louisiana Office of Behavioral Health (OBH) used pay_source_1, 2 and 3 from the state Client-level Data Manual to identify types of funding support (Medicaid only, both Medicaid and non-Medicaid, non-Medicaid only and Medicaid status not available). Some additional/internal data files were also used per guidance from last year's URS table edit check. The overall data quality in pay_source improved during the most recent state fiscal year. Some regions that used to report only pay_source_1, now started reporting pay_source_2 and pay_source_3 with greater accuracy. Per internal methodology, if pay_source_1=Medicaid, and pay_source_2 and 3 are missing, then it is reported as Medicaid only. Clients of this combination/category decreased compared to last year as more non-Medicaid options (e.g. Personal Resource) were reported under pay_source_2 and pay_source_3. One of the regions was found to have reported high number of pay_source_2 and 3 as Personal Resources that increased the counts in Medicaid and non-Medicaid category. As part of regular data quality monitoring, Louisiana OBH reached out to that region to validate their mapping. The health region confirmed that re-mapping was done for select data points in November 2018, which generated more accurate data.
6	Total Admissions to Community Program During the Year: Total admissions decreased compared to last year in all three categories of Block Grant clients (Mental Health, SUD, Co-occurring). Per internal research, LA OBH also identified three health regions that had significantly higher number of missing values in data points used to identify MH clients. OBH will closely monitor the data files from those regions in the future.
7	Total Medicaid Expenditures: Increase is due to 52 new civil beds at ELMHS with 117 new TO which increased the Uncompensated Care funding. Total Other Funds Expenditures: The decrease is due to the Crisis Counseling program that ended for the 2016 August flooding in 2018. Total Other Expenditures: In FY 2019, there were fewer self-pay clients and FY 2018 amount was higher due to dollars collected from prior years.
8	The state placed an emphasis on training and workforce development in FY 19. Therefore, additional funds were budgeted for the Training and Education category, as well as the Infrastructure Support category.
12	Percent of children served by the SMHA with co-occurring MH/SA diagnoses: Per our internal research, we found out that total number of children served with Co-occurring MH/SA diagnoses did not have a marked change between FY 2018 (5,514) and FY 2019 (5,358). However, there were fewer children reported with drug or alcohol-related problems in the Co-Occurring cohort (1,879 in FY 2018 vs. 1,474 in FY 2019), that resulted in higher percentage change. LA SMHA interprets the reduction in drug or alcohol-related problems in the 0-17 SED cohort as positive trend.
17	In FY 2019, Louisiana Health Regions (Local Governing Entities-LGEs) reported higher number of Adults with Serious Mental Illness (SMI) receiving select Evidence Based Practice (EBP) services, i.e. Illness Self-Management & Recovery, Medication Management, mostly in the Female, African-American sub-group.
