Data clean up during data migration, new data entry specifications for collection of key fields (including, but not limited to SSN, DOB) and quarterly alerts to prompt providers to review and update other client fields (for example, employment, living status, criminal justice involvement, pregnancy status) have resulted in improved reporting and the accuracy of deduplication over the past several years. In addition, consistency has improved due to quarterly trainings for providers on system updates and due to the creation of a library of recorded video trainings for users.

3	Overall, the expected trends from 2018 to 2019 were consistent across gender and age, except for an increase in number of persons served in State Psychiatric Hospitals which increased by 28.98% (632 persons served). The total number of females served were less than (104) than males (528) and the largest increase for both genders at the State Psychiatric Hospitals were within the 21 - 64 age group. Continued efforts are still needed with community providers to enter complete and accurate information about the demographics of each person served. Training to highlight this need will continue.
