Improvements in data quality for 2016 and 2017 resulted in upward revision of those years' counts. 2018 and 2019 remain unchanged, as does the general downward trend. Reductions in admissions are largely the result of successful efforts to reduce institutionalization. NH has invested large amounts of resources to this end.
4	Employment Status is a data point that is closely monitored both locally and centrally. The expectation is that employment status is updated by providers on a quarterly basis. Engagement and enrollment in Supported Employment services is measured, and penetration rates are closely monitored. The priority placed upon enrollment, reporting, and monitoring has increased employment.
