2A	New Mexico added new services to our Medicaid program in 2019 through an 1115 Waiver which increased services available to consumers. As services increased, consumers in our Medicaid program were able to access services which were not available to them under the prior 1115 waiver. As access to NM's Behavioral Health Medicaid program increases we expect to see more consumer served through the program.
3	During the 2019 reporting period, NM increased Community Comprehensive Support Services (CCSS) and Psychosocial Rehabilitation services which allowed for more consumers to access Community Mental Health Programs. For example, there was an increase of 16,332 units of CCSS rendered during the reporting period over 2018. Regarding the decrease since 2009 of clients in SPH: New Mexico has put a lot of focus on increasing community treatment to prevent admissions into the State Hospital when not fully fit. As community services and access to these programs is more widely available across the state, the number of state hospital residents has declined over the past several years. This is a positive trend that will continue as we continue to build community treatment programs throughout the state.
4	There was a change made in 2019 to gather more employment information on consumers served during the year. During the reporting period, we continued to collect employment information as we have in the past from our client registration system, however we did increase reporting by running a match against our Medicaid eligibility system ASPEN as we did not have information on those consumers in the past. As we did improve data collection, we were able to improve reporting on employment status. Although we were able to improve the number reported, we are looking at other match alternatives to better report this criteria in the future. Regarding the lack of reporting of unemployed clients: The numbers were re-run and the development team discovered the initial data from our client registration system was overwritten by the new process of matching against our Medicaid eligibility system ASPEN. The number of unemployed we should have reported is 5,752 for 2019. Regarding the lack of reporting of clients not in the labor force: The numbers were re-run and the development team discovered the initial data from our client registration system was overwritten by the new process of matching against our Medicaid eligibility system ASPEN. The number of 'Not In Labor Force' we should have reported is 2,416 for 2019.
5A	New Mexico added new services to our Medicaid program in 2019 through an 1115 SUD Waiver which increased services available to consumers. New Mexico is a Medicaid expansion state and many citizens in the state rely on the program to receive their healthcare needs. In addition to being an expansion state, we have initiated new services through 1115 CMS waiver that opened up services to consumers that were not available years prior. This is the reason for the decrease in the non-Medicaid population as services for which non-Medicaid only paid for can now be rendered by a provider who may bill Medicaid. In addition, providers are also asked to check eligibility of consumers to ensure Medicaid funds are utilized when applicable.
6	New Mexico served more consumers during 2019 which increased the number of admissions to Community Programs during the year. The change in the number of clients in other psychiatric inpatient settings at the beginning of the year and admissions to other psychiatric inpatient settings are due to the change in Client Treatment Status at the Start of the Year for 2019 CLD reporting which is different than how we reported in the past. These changes are attributed to the CLDF reporting. Change in the LOS of adults in the SPH: We had more days that fit the criteria to calculate the average in 2018 (636) and for 2019 (284). With more clients that fit the criteria, we had a smaller average in 2018. There was a larger difference between the admission date and discharge date in 2019. Change in the LOS of clients in the SPH at the end of the year (< 1 year): In 2019 we didn't have any clients that fit this criteria. In 2018 we had 1 client with 99 day difference between Admission and Discharge.

7	<p>The Medicaid ambulatory/non-24 hour care is provided by the Medicaid (Medical Assistance Division) agency within the state of New Mexico. They tabulate this number from out-patient claims for the time period of 7/1/2018 through 6/30/2019. During the review period, the agency did see a switch in managed care organizations (MCO) which removed two prior MCOs and added a new one. During this time, the Medical Assistance Division also underwent capitation adjustments from the prior year which accounted for a jump in the total amount paid in claims from the prior review period. The totals for Medicaid spending are based on two factors: Fee-for-Service Claims = Indicates government dollars spent on claims. Capitation (Managed Care Population) = Per Member Per Month paid by Medicaid (State+Federal) to the Managed Care Organizations. The total for the ambulatory/non-24 hour care is based on paid claims (fee-for-service) and capitation for services rendered during the review period. Claim type "O"/"Outpatient" and pertaining only to Behavioral Health "BH" claims - physical health totals are not included in the total. ESMI expenditures for FY19 spanning from 07/01/2018 to 06/30/2019, encompasses two federal awards CMHS17 &amp; CMHS18. 10% set aside is based on total federal grant award which spans multiple state fiscal years. Due to an oversight the ESMI allocation for state fiscal year 19 was not increased based on the total grant award for federal fiscal year 18 thus creating a .5% shortfall. Allocations adjustments have been made for CMHS19 so that FFY 21 reporting is in compliance as follows: 1. Additional funds will be added to the ESMI provider for State fiscal year 21. 2. Weekly monitoring of expenditures continues as usual. An increase in Community Comprehensive Support Services (CCSS) and Psychosocial Rehabilitation during 2019 were the drivers for the increased MHBG expenditures during the report period. For example, there was an increase of 16,332 units of CCSS rendered during the reporting period over 2018. NM HSD-BHSD has a limited view on expenditures for the State Hospital as it is run by our partner agency the New Mexico Department of Health. As we do have a limited view on expenditures our reported amount is not fully reflective of the entire State Hospital. Since 2017, when Table 7 was added to the URS we have been reporting what we know was expended on the end on our agency but will look to our partner agency to provide full totals in the next report period and forward. Other Expenditures increased in FY19 to match the same increase in total grant award. HSDCM03718 was increased by \$1,013,795.00 from HSDCM03717.</p>
