All funds appropriated based on session law 2018-5 were not obligated. Due to these and related delays, funds that were allocated to the LME/MCOs were not fully expended and funds through a contract were not encumbered or fully expended in SFY19.
14A	There was an increase in multiracial consumers when comparing 2018 to 2019. We compared consumers with 1 or more readmissions and there is a trend and it shows where persons that previously identified themselves as a single race now identifying themselves as multiracial.
16	During data integrity checking it was discovered that some of our LME/MCOs were using the 'Living Arrangement' value of 'Unknown' at a much higher rate when compared to other LME/MCOs. It was determined that there was a programming error with some of the LME/MCOs software and the LME/MCOs were requested to send in update records to fix the issue. When comparing SFY19 to SFY18 the values of Living Arrangement for Private Residence and Homeless/Shelter are now normalizing to the correct percentages due to the correction of the software error and the subsequent change records that were submitted.
16	Data depict clients in the MH-TEDS DSS System by their SMI/SED Status and the receipt of ACT, TFC, or MSS services as verified in the Claims System (NCTRACKS). SFY2018 used a broader definition of SMI/SED than was used in the SFY2019 calculation. The SFY2019 definition of SMI/SED matches what NC is currently using in the TEDS data submission and was selected for use this year for data parity with the data submitted to DSS.
