3	The reduction in the numbers of persons served at the state hospital since 2005-2006 is attributed to a number of events within Wyoming's public health system. Initially, new funding came into the system for the development of community residential services and supports. Funding was also made available for the development of community based crisis stabilization programs. More clients were transitioning into the community system and more clients were being diverted from the state hospital. The state hospital constructed a new building for adult psychiatric services and the bed capacity of the state hospital was reduced. We then saw a rise in local hospitals treating clients in their communities due to reduction of state hospital beds. Over the past five years the work of the legislative facility task force has resulted in an entire new physical plant at the state hospital with a new mission. The bed capacity has been reduced even more. It's unknown at this time how the new mission and bed capacity will impact the volume of future admissions.
7	Increase in MHBG expenditures for Ambulatory/Community Non-24-hour Care from FY18 to FY19 is due to federal funds closeout on contracts and how the funds were divided within the contracts. Decrease in total Administration expenditures is due to a large one time expense on admin costs in FY18. Other Federal Funds expenditures in previous reports included AOT grant; also includes payment breakout in contracts. Administration Other Federal Funds: Previous report did not include the MAT Grant and has reduced numbers. AOT and PATH is included in both FY18 and FY19. CST Funds are removed due to relation to Substance Abuse, not Mental Health. Other 24-Hour State Funds: Includes Crisis Stabilization and transitional housing, like the last report. Administration State Funds: 200 and 300 contracts only reported; leaving only 207 subscription services available to report. Subscriptions can range from two year, one year, to canceling subscriptions - this effects the total of this category.

This caused a significant increase in the number of SMI served, though it's more due to better reporting than a huge influx of SMI clients.
16A	Programs have gotten past the start-up phase and now are now fully serving the ESMI population.
