DESCRIPTION: SAMHSA/CMHS is accepting applications for fiscal year (FY) 2023 Assertive Community Treatment Grants (Short Title: ACT). The purpose of this program is to establish or expand and maintain ACT programs for transition-aged youth and adults with a SMI or SED. Recipients are expected to implement an ACT program to fidelity and provide ACT services to the population of focus. With this program, SAMHSA aims to improve behavioral health outcomes for individuals by reducing rates of hospitalization, mortality, substance use, homelessness, and involvement with the criminal justice system. Eligibility is limited to states, political subdivisions of a state, Indian tribes or tribal organizations, mental health systems, health care facilities, and entities that serve individuals with serious mental illness who experience homelessness or are justice-involved.
