The webinar will be led by SAMHSA Center for Mental Health Services staff.

The purpose of this program is to provide resources to enhance the capacity of statewide mental health family-controlled organizations to engage with family members/primary caregivers who are raising children, youth, and young adults with serious emotional disturbance (SED) and/or co-occurring disorders (COD). Award recipients will be expected to be family-driven, trauma-informed, culturally relevant, holistic, and resiliency-oriented family-controlled organizations. With this program, SAMHSA aims to transform mental health and related systems in states by empowering family-controlled organizations to participate meaningfully in SED/COD policy development and service delivery.
