


## DOWNLOADING YOUR SAMHSA CONTINUATION APPLICATION PACKAGE FROM GRANTS.GOV

Grantees are encouraged to submit their continuation applications early enough to resolve any unanticipated difficulties.

- 1.) Go to [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov).
- 2) Under Applicants tab, select “Apply for Grants”.



- 3.) On the right side of the screen, click on button that says, ‘Get application Package’.



4.) In the Funding Opportunity Number box, enter the opportunity number, **SAMHSACONTINUATION2016**, and click on 'Search' button.
