DESCRIPTION: SAMHSA/CMHS is accepting applications for fiscal year (FY) 2023 Behavioral Health Partnership for Early Diversion of Adults and Youth (Short Title: Early Diversion). The purpose of this program is to establish or expand programs that divert adults and/or youth with a mental or a co-occurring disorder (COD) from the criminal or juvenile justice system to community-based mental health and substance use disorder services (SUD) and other supports prior to arrest and booking. With this program, SAMHSA aims to reduce the number of youth and adults with mental illness or COD that are involved in the criminal justice system. Eligibility is limited to states, political subdivisions of a state, Indian tribes or tribal organizations, and public or non-profit entities.
