The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) is announcing a webinar for prospective applicants interested in applying for fiscal year 2024 Statewide Consumer Network grants (Short title: SCN), NOFO SM-24-002. The webinar and conference call will be led by SAMHSA Center for Mental Health Services staff.

The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Mental Health Services (CMHS), is accepting applications for the fiscal year (FY) 2024 Statewide Consumer Network (Short title: SCN) program. The purpose of this program is to strengthen the capacity of statewide mental health peer-led organizations to partner with state efforts to improve mental health support system and related services for individuals with serious mental illness (SMI) or serious emotional disturbance (SED) as agents of transformation. Recipients will be expected to promote activities to enhance and expand mental health peer leadership, voice, and engagement, such as the expansion of the statewide peer-led network mission and reach, training, leadership, and skills development; mental health peer support; and peer certification standards.

With this program, SAMHSA aims to build the capacity of peer-led organizations and individuals with lived experience to engage in crisis planning, early intervention and crisis response; diversity and cultural responsiveness; partnership development, and integrated care across the United States.
