

ANNOUNCEMENT OF SAMHSA WEBINAR
January 25, 2024

NOFO# SP-23-004 (FY 2024): Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for Communities, Local Governments, Universities, Colleges, and Tribes/Tribal Organizations (Short Title: SPF-PFS-Communities/Tribes)

Hosted by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP), Division of Primary Prevention (DPP).

Description: On November 16, 2023, SAMHSA released a notice of funding opportunity under the [Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for Communities, Local Governments, Universities, Colleges, and Tribes/Tribal Organizations](#) grant program. The purpose of the SPF- PFS program is to help reduce the onset and progression of substance use and related problems by supporting the development and delivery of community-based substance use prevention and mental health promotion services. The program is intended to expand and strengthen the capacity of local community prevention providers to implement evidence-based prevention programs. With this program SAMHSA aims to strengthen state and community-level prevention capacity to identify and address local substance use prevention concerns, such as underage drinking, marijuana, tobacco, electronic cigarettes, opioids, methamphetamine, and heroin. Recipients will be expected to utilize local, state, and national substance use public health data to identify underserved communities and sub-populations of focus, identify prevention priorities in their state, and develop and implement strategies to prevent the use of substances.

In FY 2024, SAMHSA is providing funding estimated at \$15,500,000. Awards will be provided up to \$375,000 per year for five years. SAMHSA expects to make 41 awards in 2024. The Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for Communities, Local Governments, Universities, Colleges, and Tribes/Tribal Organizations notice of funding opportunity for FY 2024 closes on **February 21, 2024**. Prospective applicants are encouraged to attend the upcoming **SPF-PFS-Communities/Tribes (FY 2024) Pre-Application Webinar on Thursday, January 25, 2024, at 2:00 pm Eastern Time**. The webinar will provide an overview of the grant program, eligibility criteria, required/allowable activities, data collection requirements, funding limitations, and application evaluation criteria.
