

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF SAMHSA WEBINAR**  
**May 16, 2023**

**NOFO# SP-23-003: Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for States**  
**(Short Title: SPF-PFS-States)**

Hosted by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP), Division of Primary Prevention (DPP).

**Description:** On April 3, 2023, SAMHSA released a notice of funding opportunity under the [Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for States](#) grant program. The purpose of the SPF-PFS program is to help reduce the onset and progression of substance misuse and its related problems by supporting the development and delivery of state and community substance misuse prevention and mental health promotion services. This program is intended to promote substance use prevention throughout a state jurisdiction for individuals and families by building and expanding the capacity of local community prevention providers to implement evidence-based programs. With this program, SAMHSA aims to strengthen state and community-level prevention capacity to identify and address local substance use prevention concerns, such as underage drinking, marijuana, tobacco, electronic cigarettes, opioids, methamphetamine, and heroin. Recipients will be expected to utilize local, state, and national substance use public health data to identify underserved communities, identify prevention priorities in their state, and develop and implement strategies to prevent the misuse of substances.

In FY 2023, SAMHSA is providing funding estimated at \$17,500,000. Awards will be provided up to \$1,250,000 per year for five years. SAMHSA expects to make 14 awards in 2023. The Strategic Prevention Framework-Partnerships for Success for States notice of funding opportunity for FY 2023 closes on **June 5, 2023**. Prospective applicants are encouraged to attend the upcoming **SPF-PFS-States Prospective Application NOFO Webinar on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, at 3:00 pm Eastern Time**. The webinar will provide an overview of the grant program, eligibility criteria, required/allowable activities, data collection requirements, funding limitations, and application evaluation criteria.
