The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) is announcing a webinar for prospective applicants interested in applying for fiscal year 2017 Cooperative Agreements to Implement Zero Suicide in Health Systems (Short Title: Zero Suicide) (SM-17-006). This will be led by SAMHSA Center for Mental Health Services staff.

The purpose of this program is to implement suicide prevention and intervention programs, for individuals who are 25 years of age or older, that are designed to raise awareness of suicide, establish referral processes, and improve care and outcomes for such individuals who are at risk for suicide. Grantees will implement all components of the Zero Suicide model throughout their health system.
