### FOA: SM-18-018: Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health Grant Program

Hosted by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Mental Health Services (CMHS), Mental Health Promotion Branch.

**DURATION:** 1 hour

- **DESCRIPTION:** SAMHSA/CMHS is accepting applications for fiscal year (FY) 2018 Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health Grants. The purpose of this program is to ensure that young children and families have access to a full continuum of mental health services, including prevention, early identification, early intervention and treatment. The program will aid in addressing the shortage of mental health professionals with infant and early childhood expertise. Eligibility is limited to human service agencies or non-profit institutions that: (1) employ licensed mental health professionals who have specialized training and experience in infant and early childhood assessment, diagnosis, and treatment; OR are accredited or approved by the appropriate State agency, as applicable, to provide mental health promotion, intervention, and/or treatment services for children from birth to 12 years of age; and (2) provide infant and early childhood services or programs that are evidence-based or that have been scientifically demonstrated to show further promise but would benefit from further applied development.
