History I

- DTAB – April, 1997. Three day open meeting – alternative specimens & techniques
- Pilot PTs – April, 2000 to 2007
- Draft of Guidelines for Alternative Specimens – June, 2000.
- Federal Register, Issued in 2004. Guidelines for Alternative Specimens
- *Recommendation by the DTAB- Aug, 2015)*
..Based on the review of the science, DTAB recommends that SAMHSA pursue hair as an alternative specimen in the Mandatory Guidelines for Federal Workplace Drug Testing Programs, including performance standards that sufficiently address external contamination and hair color impact...

History II

...“(B) The regulations prescribed under subparagraph (A) shall permit motor carriers—

‘(i) to conduct pre-employment testing of commercial motor vehicle operators for the use of alcohol; and‘(ii) **to use hair testing** as an acceptable alternative to urine testing—

“(I) in conducting **pre-employment testing** for the use of a controlled substance; and‘(II) In conducting **random testing for the use of a controlled substance if the operator was subject to hair testing for pre-employment testing.**”.... Oct, 2015)

(b) GUIDELINES.-Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall issue scientific and technical guide lines for hair testing as a method of detecting the use of a controlled substance for purposes of section 31306 of title 49, United States Code.

 - 1) Collection, growth & rate, 2) Decontamination; 3) Potential impact of hair color & treatment; 4) Incorporation of drugs, metabolites, and other target compounds; 5) Contamination; 6) Which drugs, metabolites and other target markers; 7) Testing methods; 8) Interpretation & MRO; and 9) Assessing laboratory performance.




