Short Title: PCSS-MOUD**

The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) is announcing a webinar for prospective applicants interested in applying for fiscal year 2023 Provider's Clinical Support System – Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (Short title: PCSS-MOUD), NOFO TI-23-014. The webinar will be led by SAMHSA Center for Substance Abuse Treatment staff.

The purpose of this program is to provide training, guidance, and mentoring on the use of Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD). It is intended to enhance the capacity of healthcare and counseling professionals to identify and treat opioid use disorder (OUD). The program will focus on providing front-line support to integrate substance use disorder (SUD) training and the use of medications for treatment of OUD into mainstream health care by advancing workforce training and mentorship and expanding practitioners' knowledge of available evidence-based treatment approaches. It is meant to enable multidisciplinary professionals to facilitate screening for SUD, with a particular focus on OUD, in all areas of health care, ensure eligible practitioners can prescribe MOUD, facilitate access to other treatment and supports their patients might need to restore their health and well-being and engage people with SUDs into treatment. It will encourage use of multidisciplinary teams and promote patient-centered responses to the need for treatment.

Eligible applicants are professional associations authorized under Section 1263 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 to carry out substance use disorder training of practitioners seeking or renewing registration from the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).
