TELEVISION & FILM PRODUCTION NOMINATION FORM

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Do you know of a television or film production that has done an outstanding job of including a dignified, respectful, and accurate portrayal of people with mental and/or substance use disorders? Nominate it for a 2016 Voice Award.

Eligible productions should emphasize the positive journey of recovery from these conditions and must have aired in a public setting after **April 15, 2015**.

This year, special consideration will be given to film and television productions that portray the positive impact that family members can have on their loved one's path to recovery.

Nominations are due by Friday, April 29, 2016.

Nominations are open to anyone. There is no limit to the number of nominations an individual can submit, and self-nominations are welcome.

NOTE: Only productions that have been distributed within the U.S. (i.e., released in theaters, aired on television or cable networks, streamed online, or aired in a public setting) are eligible for a Voice Award.
