NARRATOR: IT'S NOT TOO EARLY TO TALK TO YOUR CHILD ABOUT DRINKING. FOR TIPS ON WHAT TO SAY, VISIT UNDERAGEDRINKING-DOT-SAMHSA-DOT-GOV. THAT'S WWW-DOT-UNDERAGEDRINKING-DOT-S-A-M-H-S-A-DOT-GOV. THIS MESSAGE BROUGHT TO YOU BY SAMHSA AND THIS STATION.

[SOUNDS OF FOOD COOKING IN A KITCHEN]

CHILD: HI GRANDMA! CAN NINA COME OVER FOR DINNER?

GRANDMOTHER: SURE. (pause) I'VE BEEN MEANING TO ASK YOU: WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF SOMEONE OFFERED YOU A DRINK?

CHILD [reproachful, not defensive]: GRANDMA!

GRANDMOTHER: IF ANYONE EVER DOES, I WANT YOU TO SAY, "NO. I HAVE TOO MUCH RESPECT FOR MY FAMILY. AND I DON'T WANT TO GET IN TROUBLE"

CHILD [agreeable/friendly]: I PROMISE, GRANDMA.

[MUSIC]

NARRATOR: THEY REALLY DO HEAR YOU. FOR TIPS ON WHAT TO SAY, VISIT UNDERAGEDRINKING-DOT-SAMHSA-DOT-GOV. THAT'S WWW-DOT-UNDERAGEDRINKING-DOT-S-A-M-H-S-A-DOT-GOV. THIS MESSAGE BROUGHT TO YOU BY SAMHSA AND THIS STATION.

[SOUNDS OF FOOD COOKING IN A KITCHEN]

CHILD: HI GRANDMA! WHAT'S FOR DINNER?

GRANDMOTHER: HEY HONEY. I'M MAKING STEW TONIGHT.

CHILD [excited/animated]: OOOH! CAN NINA COME OVER?

GRANDMOTHER [echo effects to demonstrate grandmother thinking]: I'M NOT SURE ABOUT HER NEW FRIEND. I WONDER IF THERE'S BEEN ANY DRINKING GOING ON. ALCOHOL AT HER AGE CAN LEAD TO SO MANY BAD THINGS.

GRANDMOTHER: I'VE BEEN MEANING TO ASK YOU: WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF SOMEONE OFFERED YOU A DRINK?

CHILD [reproachful, not defensive]: GRANDMA!

GRANDMOTHER [nervous/apprehensive] [echo effects to demonstrate grandmother thinking]: THIS IS HARD. SHE'S SO YOUNG. BUT I KNOW I NEED TO TALK TO HER ABOUT IT NOW, BEFORE SOMEONE TRIES TO GIVE HER ALCOHOL.

GRANDMOTHER: IF ANYONE EVER DOES OFFER YOU A DRINK, I WANT YOU TO SAY, "NO. I HAVE TOO MUCH RESPECT FOR MY FAMILY, AND I DON'T WANT TO GET IN TROUBLE."

CHILD: OKAY.

GRANDMOTHER [concerned]: REALLY?

CHILD [agreeable/friendly]: I PROMISE, GRANDMA.

CHILD [echo effects to demonstrate child thinking]: I LOVE YOU, TOO.

GRANDMOTHER: OKAY, HOW ABOUT TASTING THIS STEW AND TELLING ME WHAT YOU

THINK?

[LAUGHTER, KITCHEN NOISES]

CHILD: FADE OUT AS CHILD SAYS: MMMMMMM

[MUSIC]

NARRATOR: SOME CHILDREN MAY TRY ALCOHOL AS YOUNG AS NINE YEARS OLD. IT'S NOT TOO EARLY TO TALK ABOUT DRINKING. FOR TIPS ON HOW TO BEGIN THE CONVERSATION, VISIT UNDERAGEDRINKING-DOT-SAMHSA-DOT-GOV.
