- Catholic Charities, USA – National organization that offers support to member agencies, provides disaster relief and promotes poverty-reduction through research and legislative reform - <https://catholiccharitiesusa.org/>
- Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) – Therapy with special capacity to overcome the often devastating effects of psychological trauma - <http://www.emdrhap.org/content/what-is-emdr/>
- Journalism Fellowship at Dart Center – Educates journalists on the science of trauma and prepares them to interview victims and trauma survivors with sensitivity and to understand the complexity of a trauma survivor’s experiences. Fellows learn to tell more insightful, responsible, and credible reporting on trauma and those impacted directly or indirectly - <https://dartcenter.org/programs/fellowships>
- National Association of State Mental Health Program Directors (NASMHPD) – Works with states, federal partners, and stakeholders to promote wellness, recovery, and resiliency for individuals with mental health conditions or co-occurring mental health and substance-related disorders across all ages and cultural groups, including: youth, older persons, veterans and their families, and people under the jurisdiction of the court - <http://nasmhpd.org/>
- “PTSD and Veterans: A Conversation with Dr. Frank Ochberg” – Dr. Ochberg provides expert guidance to clinicians on handling the dual needs of support and exposure that are essential elements to PTSD treatment today - <https://www.psychotherapy.net/video/PTSD-veterans>
- The Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) Study – Completed by CDC-Kaiser Permanente, the ACE Study is one of the largest investigations of childhood abuse and neglect and later-life health and well-being - <https://www.cdc.gov/violenceprevention/acestudy/about.html>
- Trauma Addictions Mental Health and Recovery (TAMAR) program – Developed as part of the first phase of the SAMHSA Women, Co-Occurring Disorders and Violence Study, the TAMAR Education Project is a structured, manualized intervention combining psycho-educational approaches with expressive therapies - <https://www.samhsa.gov/nctic/trauma-interventions#tamar>
- “Breaking News, Breaking Down” – The film captures the impact on journalists covering traumatic events and the effects on them personally.
